We were the first to obtain a 'hydrogen bomb' *ex parte* order combining *Mareva*, *Anton Piller*, and *Norwich Pharmacal* relief in a single application.

We are now expanding with an eye to commencing a series of novel class actions that will contribute social value to the world.
